# Inva Low Platform Lift

# Q. Do I need to have 3 phase electric supply to the lift?

A. No. Our lift only requires a normal 240V supply.

# Q. What is the maximum travel height?

A. The unit will serve up to 1 metre.

# Q. What size is the platform?

A. The standard size is 1450mm x 900mm Wide but smaller widths are available.

# Q. What is the maximum load?

A. Maximum working load is 300Kg

# Q. What guarantee do you provide?

A. Standard 12 month parts and labour on the whole lift.

#### Q. What type of controls does the unit have?

A. Constant pressure buttons when travelling on the lift.

#### Q. Can I bridge a set of steps?

A. Yes. There is the option of adding a bridging unit to the lift.

# Q. Can I personalise my lift?

A. Yes. We can offer the lift in different colours, key locking, automatic doors and other options.

# Q. Do you need a supporting wall?

A. Yes. The front facing wall will need to be structural.

# Q. How long does an installation take?

A. On average a lift would normally be completed in 1-2 days

# Q. Am I able to have a lift with an open adjacent arrangement?

A. No. The lift is only available in an open through arrangement.

#### Q. Can I have glass on the lift?

A. Yes. We can install glass infill panels on the side of the lift and on the gate.

# Q. What stops the wheelchair from rolling off?

A. The unit has an automatic ramp which acts as a wheel stop when the lift is travelling.

# Q. Can I view a recent installation?

A. We have many installations around the UK and it is highly probable that we can arrange a visit to a site.
